I am writing to inform you that Sanofi is updating its policies related to the 340B program integrity initiative. Sanofi will continue to collect limited, de-identified claims data through 340B ESP™, Second Sight Solutions' 340B compliance platform, for 340B-priced drugs dispensed by contract pharmacies. The minimal data sought allows Sanofi to identify 340B-priced claims and to eliminate duplicate discounts that originate from 340B contract pharmacy utilization.

The changes to the policy build upon what has been previously communicated and are available on the 340B ESP™ platform for your convenience. The updates to the existing policy are outlined below:

Limitations on Replenishment Orders

Replenishment orders subject to the claims submission requirement must be placed within 45 days of the eligible claim's dispense date. Replenishment orders placed outside the 45-day window will not be eligible for 340B pricing.

De-identified claims detail must be submitted to 340B ESP™ via your TPA or directly through the 340B ESP™ web portal within 45 days of the eligible claim's date of service.

Failure to meet these requirements may result in loss of access to 340B pricing at contract pharmacy locations.

Accessing Contract Pharmacy Pricing for the First Time

To gain access to contract pharmacy pricing, you must submit eligible claims within 45 days of the dispense date.

If you are unable to produce claims submissions prior to gaining access to 340B pricing, registered users may attest their intent to submit claims and participate in the 340B program integrity initiative from your Entity Profile in the 340B ESP platform. After attesting your intent to submit 340B claims data via 340B ESP™, you will be given access to pricing at your contract pharmacy locations. If claims are not received by Sanofi via 340B ESP™ within 45 days of attesting, access to 340B pricing at contract pharmacy locations may be revoked.
